All of our flannel material is cut and squared off and most of our fleece material is the same. Our ladies have been working at home finishing the blankets for us with colorful hems, hand and machine stitched. Recently, 16 beautiful blankets and 9 chemo hats were delivered to Sanford oncology while 6 receiving blankets and 44 infant hats were delivered to Sanford nursery. Thank you to all of the Crafters who helped to make these items for our local needs! We've enjoyed our work times so much that we decided to do another work day in August. At this time we will not only work on blankets, but hats and other projects as well. So, crafters are asked to decide what they want to do and bring the appropriate equipment, such as: sewing machines, looms, knitting and crocheting supplies, etc. We have lots of yarn and blanket material in our closet. We could work on blanket hemming, infant hats, chemo hats, hats for all ages, mittens for all ages, prayer shawls, prayer scarves, or winter scarves for all ages.
