Wednesday Evening Book Study

This summer, we’ll again have a Wednesday evening book study at Calvary. Join us to take part in some great reading and fellowship!

HERE ARE THE DETAILS:

- **When:** We’ll begin on Wednesday, June 7, and meet for 6-8 consecutive weeks, ending sometime between July 12 and 26 (we’ll decide as a group when to wrap up). We will meet from 7:30–9:00pm (we’ll gather after our 6:30 worship service and the subsequent ice cream fellowship time).
- **Where:** Calvary lounge
- **What book:** *Listening for God*, volume 2, edited by Paula Carlson and Peter Hawkins. This is a collection of literature from a variety of authors; this volume includes selections from John Updike, Kathleen Norris, Carol Bly, Anne Tyler, Gail Godwin, Henry Louis Gates, Jr., Tobias Wolff, Andre Dubus. (We read volume 1 in this series last year. The pieces are not necessarily explicitly religious, but they all have faith themes, and they provide a good opportunity for conversation.) We have a companion DVD that has short clips of the authors speaking.
- **Cost:** We have free books for 17 participants, thanks to a Thrivent Action Team Grant.
- **Who:** This is open to any and all Calvary members and friends – men and women, high school age and above.

Pastor Andrew will be present for some but not all of the sessions, so we hope that several different folks will be able to facilitate some conversation. We do not yet have the books on hand, but expect that we’ll have them by June 2 or before, at which point you’ll be able to pick one up. Let Pr. Andrew know if you’d like to get a copy; we encourage couples to share a copy if possible.
