The disciples once said to Jesus, "Lord, teach us to pray," and he did: Jesus gave them and us the words that we now know as the Lord's Prayer.

I felt closer to Him and I felt peace despite not knowing what the future held. Prayer gives me peace. I give my worries, wishes, and thanks to God and He gives me peace. On Sunday, January 29th, Calvary had a new type of worship service. The service made us step out of our "worship box" and experience prayer in a new way as a community of believers. For me, experiencing prayer in many different ways as one community was extremely meaningful. After all, if we aren't comfortable with our church family, then who can we be comfortable with? The quiet and reflective time made me realize that although I feel that I pray often, I don't find the peaceful quiet that I need as often as I should. The service showed that no matter where we are physically, emotionally or spiritually that prayer can and should be a part of our lives! # Reflections on Serving Neighbors Experiencing Homelessness

In February, Calvary became an overnight shelter – a welcoming home – for about 20 adults and children in need of housing through our area's SoS program. Why do we serve like this?



"I continue to volunteer with SoS because it challenges me to put my

faith to work in a way that is sometimes not easy. It is much more convenient and less messy to 'welcome the stranger' and 'see the Christ in everyone' in the abstract. By volunteering with SoS, I must confront my discomfort with poverty, homelessness and mental illness and how this intersects with what God calls me to do as a Christian. I also learn something from the experience every time I volunteer, often through an unexpected source. I am reminded that faith is a journey, and I still have a long way to go in fully using my gifts and talents to live out my faith, so I need to keep working-SoS provides me with that opportunity. 'Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and everyone who loves the father loves his child as well' (1 John 5:1; NIV)." - Kim Williams

"God changed my heart during a SOS shift one cold winter night about 7 years ago. I actually never thought that much about the homeless and if I did, I confess I had major judgement. Then one night I sat and talked to homeless people - people that have had their fair share of way more downs than ups in life. I heard their stories and saw their gratitude and I realized that we are so much more alike than different. I realized that we are all on this journey together and homeless people want what we all do: to be loved and understood, even when we don't understand ourselves. Jesus commands us to feed the hungry and house the poor - a huge undertaking, but he never told us we have to do it alone. He sends other believers to join us on our journey! That is what Servants of Shelter is for me; a community of believers living out Matthew 25:35-40." - Sandy Hennum

## Do You Ever Have Questions Like These?

Every week we receive some wonderful questions from our confirmation families in their worship notes. They're probably questions that you share. Here, your Calvary pastors share a response to these questions. This month the response is from Pastor Nate.

#### "HOW DOES GOD TALK TO US OR CALL US?"

God speaks to us in a number of ways. In fact, God loves communicating with us. God is never hiding from us or not wanting to communicate with us. Some prominent ways God speaks to His world is through the Bible, through prayer, through what I will call Christian conversation, and through creation.

As Lutherans, we understand God communicating (loudly) to us through the Bible in really two ways (or words); the Law and Gospel. The law is that which demands from us: do this, don't do this (see Exodus 20:13-16). The gospel is that which has already been done to/for us: specifically found in Jesus Christ (for an example see John 1:1, 14). Preaching is the proclamation of God's Word and another way to hear God's voice.

God also communicates through prayer, through Christian conversation, and even through creation. When we pray, we speak and listen with God (1 Thessalonians 5:17). In Christian conversation we hear God's truths contextualized into our circumstances by a trusted friend or family member. Finally, God's amazing creation continually sings His praise (Psalm 19:1-6).

A great resource to learn more about God talking is a book called "Luther for Armchair Theologians" by Steven Paulson. It is available in our Calvary library. If you would like to hear about how we believe that God calls all people, maybe you would like to ask one of our pastors about their call story.

# 2<sup>ND</sup> OFFERING MINISTRY PARTNER



Why do we have second offering ministry partners? Couldn't the congregation use the money for its own needs? These are good questions! We give because we value the work of many ministries outside our own walls and congregation. We trust in God's abundance, and we place a high value on partnerships with others. So sharing what we have received makes good sense!

"In 2015, 11% of all Minnesotans and almost 15% of kids in Minnesota lived below the poverty line" (MN Department of Health, 2015). Poverty matters to God and to us ... and especially to those who experience it directly. Part of our response is to share food, which we do this month through the Bemidji Community Food Shelf and our annual Minnesota FoodShare campaign. In 2016, our food shelf distributed 710,705 pounds of food through the help of 828 volunteers. This is big and important work that needs to continue! The Calvary community has been a strong supporter of our food shelf, and we hope that continues this year.

Partnership is more than money! Thanks to the many Calvary people who volunteer on a regular basis at the food shelf. We're thankful, too, for the building that God has given us, as it's allowed us to house long-term Americorps volunteers who are working at the food shelf; we're hopeful that we'll be able to host these volunteers again this year. To volunteer at the food shelf with our Calvary team, call Shirley Olson at 444.6676. To share a meal with hungry people (and aren't we all hungry sometimes?), come for supper at the Community Table (formerly known as the soup kitchen), served Monday through Thursday from 5-6pm (Monday and Tuesday at Mt. Zion and Wednesday and Thursday at the United Methodist Church).

While we will take a second offering one Sunday per month (March 12), you are encouraged to give throughout the month to our ministry partners. We ask that ALL checks be made out to Calvary Lutheran. In the memo line, write our mission partner for the month. This will help with better record keeping.

#### **LENT 2017**

Every year, the church turns its attention to Jesus as he sets his face toward Jerusalem, where he will be betrayed, arrested, crucified, and buried. We call this forty-day period the season of Lent. You are invited to participate in these holy days through worship and other faith practices. Here are some of the special happenings over the course of these weeks, from March 1 through April 15.

- Noon worship services, followed by a light lunch, for six Wednesdays, beginning March 1
- Mentoring relationships for the same six Wednesday evenings, with each of our 6th, 7th, and 8th graders paired with an adult for a time of conversation and prayer
- All are Welcome to Six Monday afternoon centering prayer gatherings, beginning March 6. Room 1 at 4 p.m. for 20 minutes of quiet prayer with other Christians
- An invitation to commit to one specific Lenten practice, which will help us grow, give, and/or serve in a new or deepened way (watch for details, but here's a summary: GROW through daily Bible reading or participation in centering prayer; GIVE through a commitment to tithe or otherwise increasing our financial generosity; SERVE by volunteering at a non-profit or hosting others in your home three times during Lent)

The point of Lent is what Jesus is doing for us, not the supposedly great sacrifices we make or the acts of piety we perform. These special happenings and practices are simply ways to help us listen to God, follow Jesus, and trust in the Spirit. In Lent - and all the time - our focus is Christ, the lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. Come, let us worship him.
