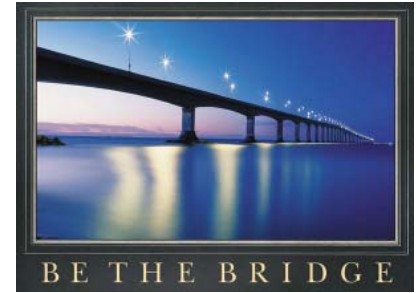

THE BRIDGE CAPITAL APPEAL**

In September, our second offering will go to support our own congregational capital appeal, The Bridge, which is now in its third and final year – we'll wrap up this cooperative effort in April of 2018. This campaign has already made a big difference in the life of our congregation! We've paid for the sanctuary and fellowship hall renovations and made significant progress on paying down our mortgage; on top of this, we've been able to substantially lower our monthly mortgage payments. However, the real value of this appeal is not dollars and cents; rather, it's the abundant generosity of God that we experience richly as we give, and the gifts of worshiping together and using our resources wisely to serve God's kingdom.

August Sermon Series - Good Questions!

Good questions abound in this congregation and in the life of Christian faith. In August and September, we've been exploring five of these questions through a sermon series. Listed below is a brief recap. If you missed a sermon, you can find and listen to it online at www.calvarybemidji.org/sermons/.

#1: August 6 – Why doesn't God just tell us everything? This sermon thinks about why we have questions in the first place and how questions fit into our relationship with God.

#2: August 13 – How do science and faith fit together? This sermon asks whether science and faith are at war and seeks to see how God is present in scientific theories about our natural world.

#3: August 20 - Why do we have mission trips? This whole worship service is led by Calvary youth who share about their summer experiences in Duluth and Daytona Beach.

#4: August 27 - What happens when we die? This sermon looks at the great and sometimes frightening mystery of death, together with God's promises of resurrection and eternal life.

#5: September 3 – Why do we have sacraments? This sermon is about how God comes to us through water and the word, wine and bread, and why these “means of grace” matter.

A Message From Calvary's First YAGM - Levi Heath



This year I will be serving as a volunteer for the ELCA's Young Adults in Global Mission program. I will be living in Hungary and working with the Lutheran Mission Center based in Balatonszárszó, Hungary; and, in particular, with its ministries in the villages of Kötöcse & Nagycsepely. I have also been asked to teach some Roma children to play guitar. I am particularly excited to serve with the Lutheran Church in Central Europe because of the work they do with Roma communities. As a white man living in America I benefit greatly from the way society is structured. While I am grateful for the opportunities I have, I feel that I have a responsibility to help those less privileged than myself. As such, I look forward to the year ahead of me as learn how to responsibly use the voice I have.
