Paul is writing to his friends in Rome who he will not see for three more years. Paul writes in verse 16, “For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile.”

Every Day with God

Paul never lets his followers forget that he is all about the gospel and that his mission is to help others love the gospel as much as he does. Tell others about the gospel, regardless of who they are, helps him feel better and even look better. As he says, “I am not ashamed of the gospel...” He is particularly concerned about those who he will not see for a while. Will they forget Jesus? Will they forget about salvation? If he doesn’t remind them, who will?

If we are silent about Jesus around people who do not know Jesus well or not at all, who will tell them? Will we have the courage?
