We close out the Book of Romans. Paul is telling his friends that he is on his way back to Jerusalem but intends to go to Spain. On his way he plans to stop and see his fellow Christians in Rome. In the earlier verses in this chapter he mentions many of his friends by name and thanks them for their abiding faith. He confesses again that the Old Testament prophecies have been fulfilled which lead them to Jesus Christ and glory forever and ever. He closes the Romans with “Amen” meaning “this is it,” or this is all we need to know.
