## Philippians 2:5-8 Who Should You and I Be Like?

Did you ever wonder how God really wants us to act? Paul tells us in Philippians. "In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death- even death on a cross!"

## **Every Day with God**

What does it mean to have the same mindset as Jesus? Jesus appeared on earth as a human being just like you and I. He appeared and took on the likeness of a servant. He came to serve others; he was humble; he was obedient to his father.
