

DEVOTIONS

Think about devotions as a continuation of our community's worship. The following basic pattern could be one way of forming your household's devotions. Adapt as necessary!

GATHERING

✠ Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

✠ Prayer of the Week

God of the Resurrection, create in us a new life. You gave breath to Lazarus, and we ask that you fill us with the same breath of life. In the midst of our daily routine, fill us with your Holy Spirit so that we can share in full our lives with others. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- 🔗 **Highs & Lows:** Name one thing that brought you happiness today. Name one thing that did not make you happy.
- 🔗 **Thinking about This Week's Story:** Upon receiving the news that Lazarus was sick, Jesus returned to Bethany. In the meantime, Lazarus died. Even though Jesus ends up saving Lazarus from death, Jesus cried. What has made you sad or upset today? What brought you comfort?
- 🔗 **Getting Ready for Next Week's Story:** Jesus washes the feet of the disciples and sets before them a new command to love one another. When did you show love today? When did others show you love?

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

- ✠ Ask one person in your group to be Lazarus. Wrap them with a roll of toilet paper. Say the Lord's Prayer together and at the end say, "Come out, Lazarus!" Have the person then break through the paper and rejoice in new life together.


CLOSING
